

GUIDELINES FOR STUDENT DRESS

We believe that appropriate clothing for school contributes to a student's overall attitude. The appearance of students is a direct reflection of the pride in themselves and in their school. Students are to wear clothing that is not disruptive to the educational process, or offensive towards others. The following are guidelines for clothing attire at Earl Warren Middle School. It is expected that students will:

1. Wear shirts and blouses that are at least waist length and do not expose the stomach area.
2. Wear skirts that are an appropriate length for school(fingertip length when hands are by your side).
3. Wear shorts that are of appropriate length(closed fist length when hands are by your side). No short shorts.
4. Wear clothing that does not advertise the use of tobacco, alcohol, drugs, and/or violence.
5. Wear shirts/clothing appropriate for school. Offensive or inappropriate slogans and pictures are not appropriate.
6. Wear clothing that does not interfere with learning. Tube tops, spaghetti strap tops, tank tops with low cut underarms, backless tops or tops that expose the midriff, can interfere with learning in the middle school. (No tops that expose the midriff, even if worn under jackets).
7. Wear clothing that fits. Sagging pants and exposed underwear are inappropriate.
8. Wear shoes at all times.
9. Be safe. Chains of any kind or spiked apparel is not permitted.



Students who choose to disregard the guidelines for clothing attire could receive the following consequences:

1. Student may be asked to turn shirt inside out.
2. Telephone call to parents for a change of clothes.
3. Student may be asked to change into PE uniform.
4. Student may be sent home.
5. Disciplinary action.
