APT/Homeroom



- Academic Practice Time
- 30 minutes
- Every day before lunch.
- Time to do homework, read, or study
- Don't save your homework for your 5th or 6th period class for APT!
- Time for interventions, workshops, enrichment, and to meet with teachers to take care of business

Agendas

Behavior

- Tardies
 - Without an excuse = Detention
 - You have plenty of time to get to class!

- Detentions

 - Before school on Tuesdays, After School on Thursdays
- Referral
 - If your teacher has given you warnings, they may send you to the assistant principal.
