

SDUHSD Middle School Math Course Selection Philosophy and Policy

Most students will be enrolled in their grade level college prep math course. Some students may elect to access our honors level math courses. Other students will be recommended for a below grade level math course. Below grade level math courses incorporate individualized computer based programs.

Integrated Math B Honors for 7th graders is considered a “grade skip”. In order for 7th graders to enroll in this course, they must meet the following criteria. No exceptions. Integrated Math B Honors for 7th graders is the only course selection district wide in which parents / students are **NOT permitted to enroll without meeting the criteria.**

A student **must** meet the criteria listed below to be eligible to enroll in Integrated Math B Honors as a 7th grader:

1. 70% or better on the SDUHSD Integrated Math Readiness Test

SDUHSD Board Policy allows for a student to drop or change math course levels up to the end of the fourth week of school. It is important that students are placed carefully. Please follow our recommendations for math placement. Transferring Math levels, even during the first four weeks is difficult for 7th graders. After four weeks, students are not allowed to transfer math levels, per SDUHSD Board Policy.
