REGISTRATION INSTRUCTIONS FOR 7TH GRADE COURSES

Before selecting classes, please read this sheet carefully. If you have not already pre-enrolled using the Aeries Online Enrollment, you can access the information from sduhsd.net and select ENROLLMENT. The Aeries Online Enrollment and 7th Grade Course Selection Form must both be submitted in order for your student to be registered in classes for the 2022-2023 school year.

The course selection form must be emailed to ewcourseselection@sduhsd.net or dropped aff at Earl Warren by March 15, 2022

- 1. Students are automatically enrolled in World History and 7th grade science.
- 2. Check the **English** course you would like to take. We strongly encourage you to review the English 7, English 7 Honors, Course Profiles to help guide your decision. Course Profiles are available on the Earl Warren website at ew.sduhsd.net. Select *Counseling Department* and select *Course Profiles*.
- 3. Check the **Math** course you feel is most appropriate for your student. The Math Diagnostic Placement Test (MDTP) will be administered at feeder elementary schools in April. If coming from a private or charter school contact the registrar to coordinate a time to take the MDTP. All students will be notified of their test results.
 - a. Acceleration option: SDUHSD will offer an Integrated Math B Honors Readiness Test (IMBHRT) for incoming 7th graders to demonstrate mastery of Integrated Math A Honors content. Earl Warren will adjust the schedule of students who pass the test to accelerate into IMB Honors. Visit SDUHSD.net for IMBHRT dates/sign up information.
- 4. Students must take **Physical Education (PE) or Surf PE.**
 - a. Students are unable to make any period requests for General PE or Surf PE.
 - b. Parents are responsible for transportation to Surf PE at Powerhouse Park in Del Mar in the afternoon. Surf PE is scheduled 5th period on Tuesday/Thursday or 6th period on Wednesday/Friday. Period requests cannot be requested for specific carpool situations. Due to popular demand not all students who request Surf PE will receive it. SPACE IS LIMITED. Students who are not selected will be placed in general PE.
- 5. You will have space in your schedule for **ONE YEAR-LONG ELECTIVE**. Elective Descriptions are available on the Counseling web page under Course Profiles.
- 6. A language other than English is not required for a high school diploma. Two years are required to apply to most 4-year colleges. You are advised to begin your world language by 9th or 10th grade. Earl Warren only offers Spanish. You will need to wait until high school to study another world language at SDUHSD. Please refer to high school websites for world language courses.
- 7. An *online application* is required for *Leadership* and *Advanced STEM*. Application link available on the Earl Warren website at ew.sduhsd.net. Select Registration → Elective Application.
- 8. If your student has an IEP, complete the Course Selection Form and return it by the due date along with your Enrollment packet. Course requests will be reviewed at the transition IEP meeting.
- 9. If you would like to apply for ISPE or need additional information, please visit the SDUHSD Website.
- 10. If you are not from an Elementary feeder school and are enrolling in EW, please contact the Registrar's Office in Student Services at 858-755-1558 x4410 to set up a date and time to take a math assessment. Please allow one hour for the math assessment.
